2025 MEETINGS: January 12, March 16, May 4

1. Meeting Opening

2. Matters for Decision

2.1. Closed Session

Jim Rice/Bert Boulet moved to enter into closed session; CARRIED Greg Gaudet/Tony McWhannel moved to exit closed session; CARRIED

2.1.1. Reappointment of Elaine Wasylenchuk to represent the Petrochemical Industry

Nathan Bartley/Greg Gaudet moved to recommend to the Board reappointment of Elaine Wasylenchuk to the Pressure Equipment Sub-Council to represent the Petrochemical Industry for a term ending January 31, 2028, effective immediately; CARRIED.

2.2. Potential Addition of NDT Representative to Sub-Council

The following was discussed:

- Members discussed whether an NDT representative should be added to the Pressure Equipment Sub-Council.
- Some members feel there is a lack of knowledge regarding NDT, other members feel this is rarely needed and subject matter experts could be asked for feedback on topics when necessary.
- Moving toward subject matter experts instead of industry representatives as members
 would change the make up of the sub-council. For example, there are also no subject matter
 experts for nuclear, welding, etc. on the sub-council currently.
- Some members suggested adding subject matter experts to the working groups instead of the sub-council.

4. Matters for Discussion

4.1. Working Group Reports

4.1.1. Power Engineers

The following was discussed:

• The working group had a presentation by Tom Lemming from ABSA regarding provincial statistics on power engineers.

4.1.2. Pressure Welders

The following was discussed:

• A new working group chair is needed, the group will discuss at the next meeting.

4.1.3. PESR Codes & Standards

The following was discussed:

- The working group met again to discuss the adoption of CSA B51.
- Concerns were primarily related to the introduction of impact testing and the potential effects on industry in Alberta.
- Working group members agree with the logic behind this addition but expressed concern about supply chain management issues and impacts on existing projects.
- The group would like to see a delay in implementation to give ABSA time to communicate with stakeholders and ensure a smooth implementation.
- The Administrator explained that input and recommendations from interested parties, such as the PESC and the Codes and Standards Working Group, will be extremely important for the smooth implementation of CSA B51:24.
- The Administrator asked these groups to collaborate with ABSA to provide input and recommendations that can be introduced in an Information Bulletin to address alternative approaches (e.g. objective-based), transition details (e.g., supply chain issues, existing projects) and the transition period for industry.

Greg Gaudet/Robert James move that the Pressure Equipment Sub-Council recommend to the President and CEO that Municipal Affairs delay the adoption of CSA B51:2024 for a period of 6 months; CARRIED.

4.1.4. PESR In-Service Equipment

The following was discussed:

They are continuing the AB-500 document review, have completed the AB 525 and will work on AB 506 and AB 512 next.

Nyssa Moore/Bert Boulet moved to recommend that the President and CEO forward the reviewed AB 525 document to ABSA; CARRIED.

Nyssa Moore/Greg Gaudet moved to add Trevor Seipp to the PESR In-Service Equipment working group; CARRIED.

4.1.5. Hydrogen

- Hydrogen conference will be taking place in Edmonton in May.

ASME

The next ASME BPV Code week will hold virtual meetings from February 4th to 9th, 2025 for all Sections except Sections VIII and IX. Sections VIII and IX will hold their meetings in Chattanooga, TN in the same week.

CSA

CSA B51

The CSA B51 Executive Committee is working on restructuring of the Technical Sub-Committees to follow the new structure of CSA B51. The new Technical Sub-Committees are in the process of forming. The first meetings of new Technical Sub-Committees will be held in the first quarter of 2025.

The CSA B51 Technical Committee formed the Special Working Group to review the impact testing rules in CSA B51. It is expected that this Special Working Group start its work in the first quarter of 2025.

CSA B52

The CSA B52 Technical Committee is working on:

- a code supplement that will return the requirements for class T machine rooms (clause 6.3) in CSA B52:23. The revised proposal is currently on the letter ballot. The ballot will close at the beginning of February, 2025.
- development and publication of CSA B52 Handbook.

CSA B56

Development of the new CSA B56-Power engineering-power plant staffing and rating standard has been progressing well.

The Technical Committee is working on the numerous public review comments.

The first edition is still expected in the middle of 2025.

The new standard will promote uniform rules related to:

- the classification and rating of boilers and refrigeration facilities; and
- supervision requirements for the safe management and operation of these facilities.

CSA Z662

CSA Z662 Technical Committee meeting was held from December 4th to December 6th, 2024. The meeting was held in person in Montreal. Highlights include:

- review of numerous requests for interpretations
- review of proposed code changes for the 2027 edition
- discussion on the proposed changes for requirements for hydrogen pipelines in Clause 17.

The next CSA Z662 Technical Committee (TC) meeting is scheduled from June 11th to 13th, 2025 in Ottawa, ON.
