1. Meeting Opening

The Chair called the meeting to order at 1:34 p.m.

1.1. Adoption of ASTM F2783-17

A proposal put forward by Municipal Affairs to move ahead with adoption of ASTM F2783-17 with the exception of newly-added patron powered devices was explained. Municipal Affairs is seeking to put forward legislation which would exempt section 2.4 of ASTM F2783-17 (and all future editions), except for the referenced codes on inflatables (F2374) and zip-lines (F2959).

It was questioned and clarified that inflatables and zip lines are currently regulated in Alberta, although inflatables and other devices used in private dwellings are exempt.

It was noted that Municipal Affairs' intent at the moment is to revise the regulation to suit the current practice in Alberta regarding regulating amusement rides and to facilitate timely code adoption in the amusement rides discipline.
