

National Fire Code – 2023 Alberta Edition: Code Update Requirement and Resources

Summary

The National Fire Code - 2023 Alberta Edition came into force on May 1, 2024, and a code update certification requirement has been established.

To support safety codes officers through this code change and the associated code update requirement, the Council has made some initial resources available, which can be viewed on [the Code Update section of our website](#).

Action Required

All fire safety codes officers are required to pass a short quiz on these code changes by January 27, 2025, to maintain their certification.

- **How to fulfill the requirement:** Pass an online quiz at 80% or above. You may make multiple attempts at passing the quiz.
- **Cost:** Free
- **Quiz availability date:** June 25, 2024
- **Due date:** January 27, 2025 (regardless of certification renewal date)
- **Continuing Education Credit:** 5 continuing education credits will be applied automatically

How to Complete the Code Update Requirement

To complete the requirement, you must successfully pass the associated quiz. To access the quiz as well as the associated training resources, you must register on Council Connect:

- **To register:** Search for “Quiz” in the “Course/Exam Name” search box; do not fill in any of the other boxes.
