DETAILS

How to apply

Applicants must submit the Indigenous bursary form along with all requested documents either online or by emailing certification@safetycodes.ab.ca before the application deadline.

Selection Criteria

After meeting the eligibility criteria, bursary recipients will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Financial need
 - A high potential to contribute positively to the safety codes system based on previous experience and identified interests
- These criteria will be assessed based on the applicant's submission.

Selection Committee & Process

The Safety Codes Council Indigenous Bursary committee is comprised of the following:

- The Administrator of Certification, or delegate
- The Team Lead (Certification), or delegate
- Three additional members representing safety system and/or Indigenous stakeholders from a variety of sectors and disciplines, appointed by the Administrator of Certification.

Bursary Amount

The amount of the bursary varies, but will not exceed 75% of the certification cost for the discipline and level indicated on the bursary application form.
